

Sunkoo Yuh's 'Grafted Stories' at MDC Museum of Art+Design, Miami

The Museum of Art and Design at Miami Dade College will host 'Grafted Stories' - a solo exhibition by Korean-born artist Sunkoo Yuh from November 30, 2016 through January 15, 2017.

Curated by Mindy Solomon, the exhibition features a selection of large-scale ceramic sculpture, porcelain tiles, and works on paper created during the last twelve years. The exhibition includes lushly glazed, totem-like porcelain sculptures that reflect a multicultural diaspora existence, and evoke the artist's personal history, aspects of cultural integration,

and spiritual discovery that creates order out of chaos. Folkloric Korean iconography juxtaposes with politics, religion, and the family unit in Yuh's work.
