Miami Dade wins NJCAA Championship

The Miami Dade Lady Sharks won its second straight NJCAA Division I volleyball championship at the Hutchinson Sports Arena Saturday night.

Miami Dade finished the season undefeated at 34-0, capped off by a 3-0 win over Southern Idaho. The Lady Sharks won 25-13, 25-21 and 25-18 to repeat as champions. Sun Wenting led Miami Dade with 11 kills. Massiel Matos posted a double-double with 10 kills and 15 digs. The Lady Sharks posted a hitting percentage of .282. Southern Idaho had a difficult time on offense, finishing the match with a hit percentage of .098.

Other matches: New Mexico Military won the third place match of Tyler in five sets. Polk State finished in fifth after a four-set match win over Mineral Area. Iowa Western finished in seventh after its sweep over Hill. Panola defeated Laramie County in three sets to finish ninth.
